Butte County Behavioral Health is currently hiring for various positions throughout the Department Including:

Psychiatric Health Facility (PHF):

The Butte County PHF is an inpatient psychiatric health facility where adult consumers receive treatment to assist in resolving their acute care mental health needs.

Crisis Services:

This team provides services to members in the community experiencing a mental health crisis. Crisis Services is looking to primarily fill vacancies in their Mobile Crisis Team who corresponds with Law Enforcement to mental health crisis situations in the community.

Resiliency Empowerment Support Team (REST):

This innovative team works in the community with individuals who are unhoused and have mental health, substance use and cooccurring disorders.

Positions with REST (Resiliency, Empowerment, and Support Team) include a 5% site differential on top of regular salary. Positions with Crisis Services and the PHF (Psychiatric Health Facility) include a 10% site differential on top of regular salary.



About Us

Behavioral Health has been serving Butte County for 55 years and provides care to youth and adults. Treatment consists of a continuum of prevention, early intervention, treatment, and recovery support systems.

Behavioral Health provides mental health and substance use treatment to Medi-Cal beneficiaries, and provides crisis interventions to the community, regardless of insurance status.
