Same-sex marriage became legal in Nevada. (It was 11 years after Massachusetts became the first state to legalize it and eight months before the U.S. Supreme Court legalized it in all 50.)

NRS 193 passed, allowing Nevadans to legally claim the gender that they express, even if it's different from the one they were assigned at birth.



Attorney Devon Reese became Reno's first openly gay Reno City Councilmember. On June 3, the Nevada Senate passed Joint Resolution 8, colloquially known as the "Equality Act," prohibiting discrimination on the basis of sexual orientation and gender identity in education, employment, housing, credit, jury service, public accommodations and the use of federal funds. It will appear on the ballot in 2020.
