

Iceland rises from the ashes

Beloved skating rink rebounds from arson fire

Terrie Kerth walked a visitor out the back door of Iceland Ice Skating Rink and pointed to a white, two-story wood house. It was built by her father and grandfather.

"That's where we lived when we were kids," she said, "but my three brothers and two sisters and I grew up at Iceland."

Terrie Kerth is the granddaughter of engineer-inventor William Kerth, Sr., who conceived the ice skating rink, consulted with noted Sacramento architect Charles Dean (who also designed the Sacramento War Memorial Auditorium) to build the rink and opened it in 1940.
