I think it goes a little bit beyond the city. The first thing to do is work on affordable housing for the homeless, and by affordable housing, I mean some government and state-type sponsored housing.



JANE OWEN retired

I really do. I feel our heart's in the right place, we're moving in the right direction. It's a huge thing, and we're probably not going fast enough. But I don't think a big city can move much faster.



ROSE NELSENADOR veterinarian

That's a hard question. I see the homeless all over the place. I know that [the city is] trying to do things. But I haven't seen any real changes in the parts that I see every day.



RENAE BEST market organizer

I think our mayor, that's like his main topic. But the results ...
I'm not seeing any yet.
